

General Information

Registration Fees

All registration fees are included in the tuition price.

Deposit

A \$500 deposit per camper will be required upon registration. The deposit is fully refundable until March 31, 2019. After March 31, 2019 the full deposit becomes **NONREFUNDABLE**. A Payment Option must be selected at the time of registration to pay the balance, which is due by May 10, 2019. No camper will be permitted to begin camp if there is an outstanding balance or their payment plan is in arrears. Make checks payable to Central Queens YM & YWHA. All major credit cards are accepted.

Payments and Refunds

Full payment of all fees is required by May 10, 2019. No camper will be permitted to begin camp if there is an outstanding balance or their payment plan is in arrears. DEPOSITS ARE REFUNDABLE THROUGH MARCH 31, 2019. After camp begins, there will be NO REFUND under any circumstances, even in the case of illness or if the camper leaves camp on his or her own accord, is removed from camp due to an inability to adjust, is unable to function adequately or comply with the rules and regulations of the camp. There are absolutely no refunds or transfers based on missed days due to absence or early withdrawal. Campers extending will be charged the differential. An extension will be made only if there is room in the camper's group and/or bus. **NO CAMPER WILL BE PERMITTED TO BEGIN CAMP IF THERE IS AN OUTSTANDING BALANCE OR THEIR PAYMENT PLAN IS IN ARREARS.**

Refunds and Changeovers

All refunds and changeovers must be made in writing. In case of withdrawal of application or a reduction in camping service by March 31, 2019 a full refund will be provided. Between April 1, 2019 and June 26, 2019, a refund will be made less the \$500 deposit. After camp starts, there will be NO REFUND under any circumstances.

Dismissal

The Y reserves the right to dismiss any camper from our camp program. In the event of dismissal, fees will not be refunded and the parent will be responsible for paying the balance for the session fee during which the dismissal takes place.

Extensions

All requests for extensions must be made in writing. Campers extending will be charged the differential between sessions at the fee tier in which they initially registered. An extension will be made only if there is room in the camper's group and/or bus.

Insurance

All campers are covered by the camp's Accident Insurance Policy for injuries related to camp activities. This does not cover illness. Please note - there may be a deductible for medical reimbursement. The dental insurance coverage may be limited to \$150.

Financial Assistance

Limited financial assistance, based on upon individual need, is available. Applications are available at the front desk. A personal interview may be required.

Photo Release

Camp registration implies permission to use photos and/or videos taken during camp to be used for both print and electronic media for the Y's promotion (brochures, posters, internet, ads, etc.)

Camper Referral Bonus

Camp is better with friends! When you recommend a camper to the Y who signs up for camp for the first time, you receive a \$150 finder's fee per camper mailed to you in September. The following conditions must apply: the camper must be new to the Y, completed their entire session, paid tuition in full, and not be receiving financial assistance.

Transportation

For all divisions, transportation is provided in air conditioned school buses or vans and is included in the camp fee. Pickup/drop off times vary depending on location. Extended Care hours are available.

Medical Information

Medical forms will be available prior to the start of camp. All forms must be dated between September 2018 and June 2019 in order to be valid. A completed medical form and emergency authorization form must be returned to the camp office no later than June 15, 2019. No camper is permitted to begin camp unless these forms on file.

Interviews

A personal interview may be required for new campers. The purpose of this interview is to determine how we can best meet the individual/ group needs of your camper. Acceptance of campers is contingent upon Camp Director's approval.

Lunch/Snack

A Glatt Kosher lunch program is offered for all campers. Any lunches brought from home are refrigerated upon arrival at the Campgrounds. When sending lunch with your camper, please respect the Kosher guidelines of our agency. It is recommended that lunch be packed in insulated lunch bags. All programs include a daily Glatt Kosher snack.

Trips

Registration implies permission for my camper to take part in all activities, including trips away from the campgrounds. There is no alternative child care for campers who choose not to attend a scheduled outing. Trips & locations are subject to change at the discretion of the Camp Director. Space is limited in all camps traveling on day or extended trips.
